



## WORTH ABBEY *conference facilities*

Worth Abbey, home to a community of Benedictine monks (as seen in the TV series *The Monastery*), provides an idyllic setting for conferences and professional seminars on its beautiful 500 acre estate in the Sussex countryside. Worth is situated just off the M23 and is easily accessible from London and the South East by rail and road. It is only 12 km from Gatwick airport, so is ideal for those travelling from further afield.

Built in the late 19th Century and formally part of Lord Cowdray's Estate, the **main building** houses the elegant function and banqueting rooms and the main dining room.

In 2002, Worth opened **Gervase House** which offers a very high standard of contemporary accommodation comprising 76 en-suite single rooms, tea/coffee making facilities, a large area for social events and presentations with a licenced bar and stunning views across the South Downs.
